Written in an engaging and collegial style, the book stresses the interdependence of teaching, research, and service, and the importance of achieving balance in work and personal lives.

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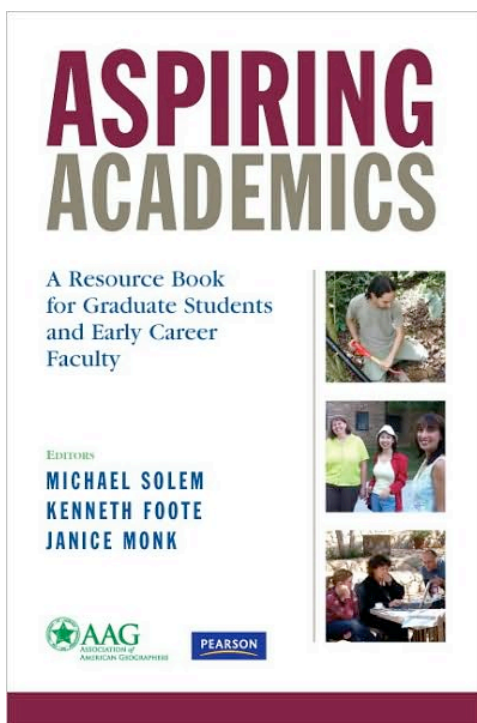
