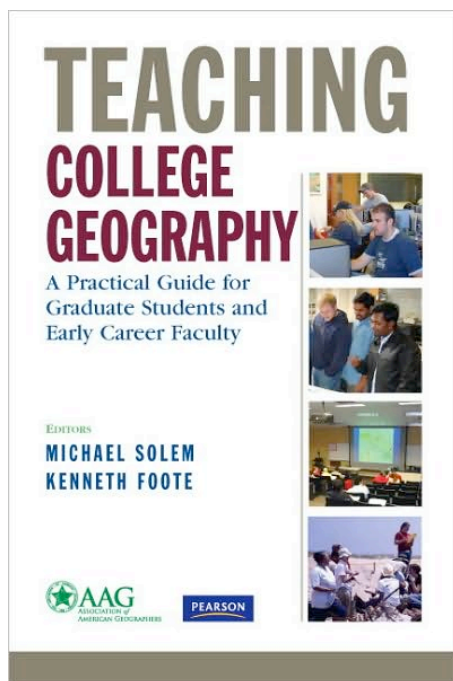


Announcing a New AAG Resource for College Geography Teachers



Teaching College Geography focuses on issues of special interest to geographers and those who teach geographic concepts and methods. The book stresses the scholarship of teaching and learning in its approach to preparing graduate teaching assistants and new faculty members for their first classroom experiences.



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Each chapter in *Teaching College Geography* is supported by **activities for professional development**. Examples include creating a teaching portfolio, using active learning strategies in large classes, and using Internet technology for international collaborative learning.

In addition, the book's **companion website** offers discussion forums on academic career issues, resource-sharing tools, and materials for workshops, graduate seminars, and faculty mentoring programs.

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
