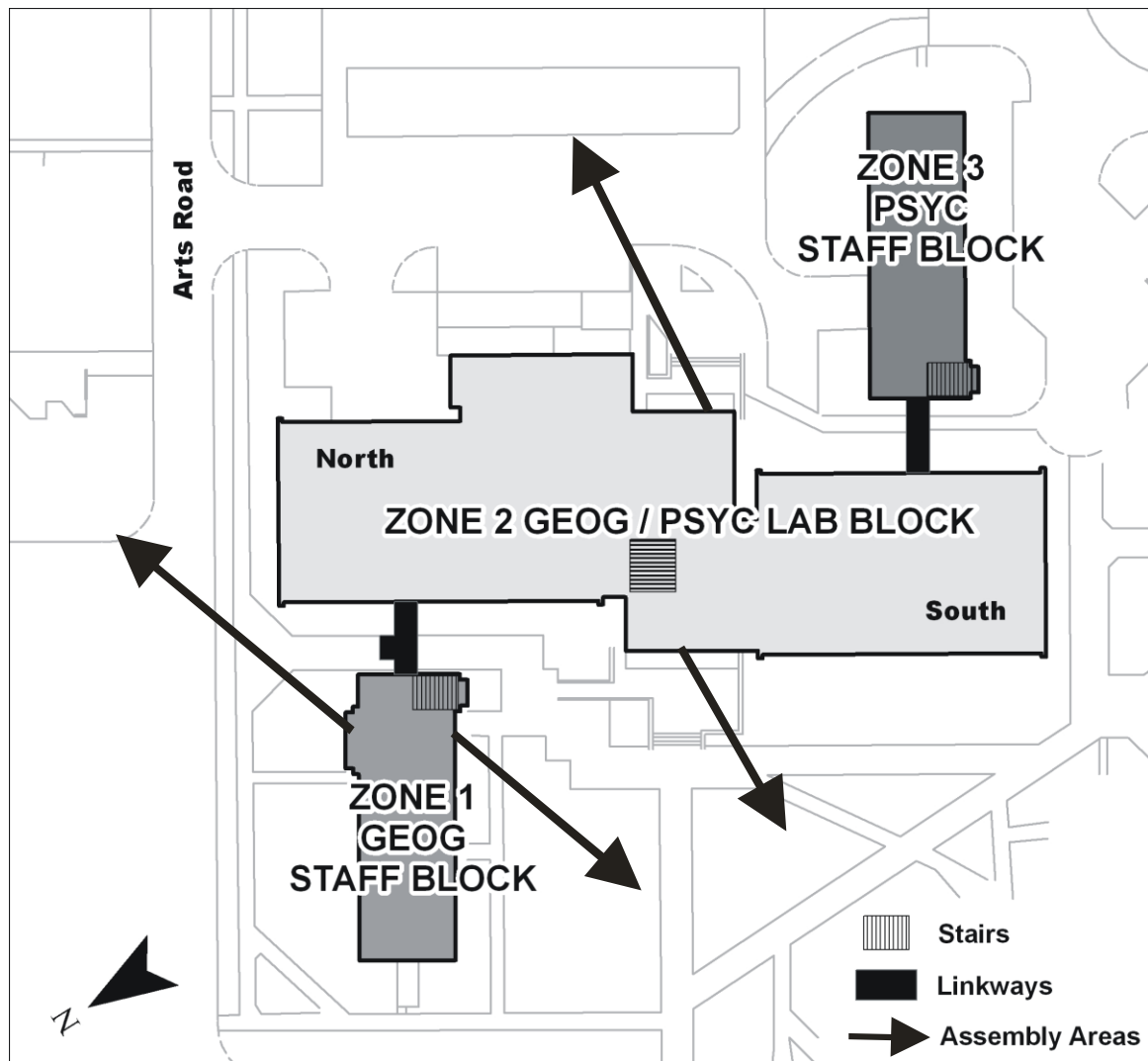


GEOG/PSYC Building Complex

Three Evacuation Zones



The GEOG/PSYC building complex is split into THREE evacuation zones, separated by linkways. If a FIRE ALARM sounds in any one zone, then ONLY that zone must evacuate, and you must not move towards or enter it.

GEOG/PSYC LAB BLOCK

Level 3 Access and EXIT

Normal access to and from Level 3 of the GEOG/PSYC LAB BLOCK is via the linkway to, and stairwell in, the GEOG STAFF BLOCK. There is an alternative FIRE EXIT at the rear of the Geography Learning Space.

In the event of an alarm sounding anywhere in the GEOG/PSYC building complex, ALL electronic EXIT and SMOKE STOP doors will release.

If you are in Level 3 of the GEOG/PSYC LAB BLOCK and want to leave while an alarm is sounding in the GEOG STAFF BLOCK, please use the FIRE EXIT at the rear of the Geography Learning Space.

- In a genuine fire alarm the EXIT doors remain released until the fire panel is reset.
- In a trial evacuation the EXIT doors only remain released while the sounders are operating.
- In a non-alarm emergency the break glass exit can be used to unlock the EXIT door.
